

thas often been said that as each Whittley boat leaves the workshop, a piece of the Whittley family heritage goes with the rig. Two generations of Whittleys have made it their life's passion to build family powerboats.

In the years when trees were felled and craftsmen built boats with hand tools, Jim Whittley and his brother Ossie built a boat for a friend. Word spread and soon Jim found a queue of people keen to sign

up for a Whittley built boat.

In the 1950's these Whittley hulls were cruisers, a pretty boat with a raked stem and nicely varnished exterior timber work. A converted 6 cylinder Holden engine provided the power.

Orders flowed in and the boat building venture moved from the

back shed to a small factory in Bulleen. The new age wonder material fibreglass became popular, and while Jim successfully made the transition from timber to fibreglass. However the Whittley brand retained enough quality timber work to set these quality boats apart from their all plastic competitors.

LOW VOLUME - HIGH

As the Whittley range has flourished and demand steadily grown, Whittley has relocated to a large 1.62 ha (4 acre) location. To ensure that the fastidious quality control standards are maintained, the majority of design, tooling and manufacturing functions are undertaken on site.

Whittley operate their own design studio, drawing on automotive industry standard computer design software.

Tooling to precise tolerances is overseen by Steve Whittley. Gelcoat work is undertaken in purpose built booths and the laminating shop is physically separated from the assembly and delivery areas to ensure a clean work environment.

A superbly equipped cabinet shop where highly experienced cabinet makers operate the latest machinery, produce all the teak consoles, doors, trim and cabinets fitted to Whittley models. Whittley also have on site a trim shop for upholstery and canopies and a glazing section where boat windows are assembled.

Through the manufacturing process there are many quality control points. However the critical quality check comes at the end of production when each individual Whittley is checked by either Neville or Steven Whittley, prior to despatch.



Cruising Lifestyle

Why limit your time on the water to a single day, when with a Whittley you can live aboard for many days at a time? Once extended cruising was the exclusive domain of the well heeled who could afford a large boat moored at the marina.



Whittley Design & Development

Whittley Cruisers has made a commitment to the future with a significant investment in their design and development studio.

In addition to technological advances, Whittley also consult their dealers and attend a number of Whittley Club rallies to gauge consumer needs in boating.

Long before the tooling for a new boat begins, the latest 'digital tools' are utilised to formulate a new boat design. Hull, deck and interior concepts are all developed using Alias three dimensional software that creates a new boat, from stem to stern, on the computer screen.

Whittley have a CNC 3-axis milling machine operating in house. This allows physical model development at early stages in the project.

Having the luxury of 3D modelling, 3D human ergonomic figures are used in


the style models. This delivers better access to human integration with the new boat.


During the design stage, Whittley designers know exactly how every aspect of the boat will look and operate. Vision angles, walkways, head clearances, hand

controls, and even open and close doors and cupboards are checked to ensure the best possible solution is delivered. Designers can even assess water flow across the hull surfaces, and also predict exact centres of buoyancy and gravity - factors critical to performance.

On the computer screen a computer generated 3D human ergonomic figure (the same 'ergoman' that car designers use) can sit at the helm then move through the boat.

It is important that he can see all the gauges, that the steering wheel is properly located and the seat height is comfortable It is vital that he can see beyond






Once a design is created on the computer screen a scale model is produced on the 3 axis-milling machine, as a final check.


The full hull and deck 'plugs' are cut out from foam blocks using a five axis cutting machine that machines to fine tolerances, thinner than the thickness of a human hair.

As a result the moulds developed by Whittley are exceptionally accurate. Not only is this a boater's guarantee of the most efficient and fair hull shape, but it also ensures that hulls and decks are uniformly precise. They fit perfectly every time to deliver exceptional performance and unsurpassed handling.

Voyager 580

The Whittley family 'Voyager' tradition continues with the Voyager 580 model, a rig that packs more usable space into every meter of hull length.

The Voyager name was first introduced to the Whittley range in 1970 and the name continued in the line up until 1983. While the Voyager layout, construction materials and design have altered a huge amount over the intervening 30 years, the basic premise that lies behind the Voyager name remains exactly the same.

This is a trailerable family cruiser that is ideal for weekend on-

board camping and extended cruising. It can be towed comfortably by a standard six cylinder family car.

The 2002 model Voyager 580 has been designed and engineered with advanced computer aided design systems. The outcome is a superb layout that makes exceptional use of every square centimetre of space on board.

Basic features include full-length, padded vee bunks, completely lined cabin and moulded cabin liner for a clean, flow-through feel. A different chine and strake layout has resulted in improved lift, reduced drag and superior handling. On the water, the 19° deadrise hull is exceptionally stable at rest and delivers a smooth ride even under bumpy conditions.

The Voyager is available in your choice of two stroke or four stroke outboard or petrol or diesel sterndrive.

This is an advanced boat that utilises the very latest in modern design and construction technology. But ultimately, the Whittley still relies upon the keen Whittley eye for fair lines and a balanced design.



The elevated helm position provides unsurpassed vision for the skipper and passenger. In fact the




Inside the boat, a comfortable forward cabin is provided with plush upholstery and vee berths. A marine toilet is included as standard equipment.





Blue water fishing doesn't get any more comfortable than this.

BRAKES

Australian law requires that where the gross weight of your boat and trailer package exceeds 750kgs, brakes are required on the trailer. Your authorised Whittley dealer will be able to advise you whether your boat package requires a trailer with brakes. He will also advise you whether you need a trailer with a single or tandem axle.

As far as brakes are concerned, Mackay offers both hydraulic disk brakes and mechanical disk brakes. Hydraulic disk brakes have better stopping power and are self adjusting. Electric drum brakes are not recommended for boating use.

GREASE SEALS

Mackay uses a special purpose two part marine seal on all axles. Cheap seals will allow excessive water penetration into the hub housing and bearing. This is the cause of the vast majority of bearing failures.

Mackay's marine seals will restrict water entering the bearings and increase the service life of bearings.

GALVANISING

It is common practice to galvanise the trailer frame, but not all manufacturers also supply galvanised springs, axles and U bolts. Mackay offers a fully galvanised suspension as a standard feature. Galvanising has no adverse impact on performance, but increases the life and durability of the Mackay trailer.

ROLLERS

It is important that your
Whittley boat is properly supported
by the roller system on the trailer.
There need to be sufficient rollers
and these also need to be placed
correctly. As a Whittley trailer boat
spends the majority of its life on the
trailer, adequate roller support is vital.
